## WHO AM I?



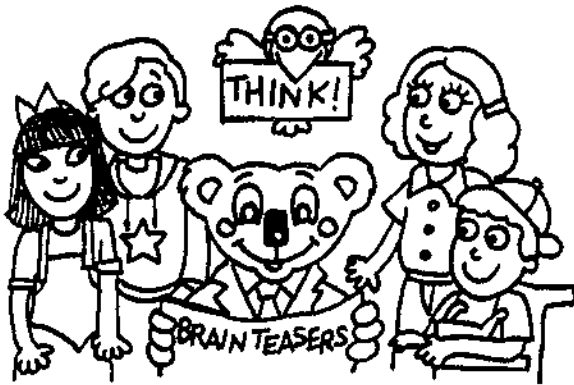

4. I was born in Africa. I was taken against my will to America and sold to work on a Southern plantation. I am a slave.
5. I am someone who opposes the idea of one person owning another. I am an abolitionist.
6. I was a leader of the first Women's Rights Convention and I drew up a list of grievances (complaints) why women were being treated unfairly. I am Elizabeth Cady Stanton.
7. In 1920 I granted women the right to vote. I was ratified by two-thirds of Congress and approved by three-fourths of the states. I am the 19th Amendment.
